CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

As our schedule changes in a few weeks and we will no longer have Mass at 9:00 on Sundays, know that we will be moving our Children's Liturgy of the Word to the 10:30 Mass beginning Sunday, July 1. Since January of the year 2000, this program has been providing young children the opportunity to listen to the scripture readings at their level. A lesson is presented and the adult leaders encourage the children to share what they have heard. It also offers them the opportunity for physical movement in the course of the Mass, which may offset the "wiggly-jiggles" which can easily take place in the confined space of a pew. If you are uncertain about your young child's ability to participate, you are welcome to accompany your child to the Children's Liturgy Room. Also, as the children reenter the Church during the offertory collection, we invite parents to stand up at that time so that their children are accustomed to finding their seats.

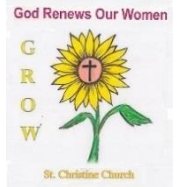
